Students and their friends can attend youth group without registering, but registering helps the church keep up to date records and get important contact info.

## What is Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual Direction is a time to talk individually with Youth Director Grace Casola over Zoom. These meetings are a time for Grace and the student to get to know each other better and to think together about how what they learn and experience in church/youth group can apply to their everyday lives.

It's called Spiritual Direction so that students know this type of conversation is something that they can engage in after they graduate from school (anyone can Google "spiritual direction" and set up a meeting with a spiritual director).

Confirmation students should set up a spiritual direction meeting once a month, and

high school students are encouraged to meet with Grace monthly as well.

## What will the students be doing?

**HS Sunday School –** These students will participate in Christian Family Faith Formation (CF3) alongside the adults. The schedule will be broken down into 5 Units: Discipleship, Lutheran History and Doctrine, Old Testament, New Testament, and the Covenants. They will spend the first seven weeks learning to identify and share how God is working in their lives.

**Youth Group** – Students who attend youth group will participate in a mix of games, Bible Study, service, and preparation for the 2022 ELCA Youth Gathering. Please refer to the schedule for the first semester that is attached.

#### Who is eligible?

Students who are in 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades in the 2021-2022 school year.

-Tuesday: boundless forgiveness-Wednesday: boundless invitation-Thursday: boundless promise

- -Interactive Learning (booths about ELCA ministries and outreach as well as games in a large civic center)
- -Service learning
- -Synod Day
- -Mass Gatherings

- -gauge who is potentially interested in attending on the youth group registration form
- -dedicate one youth group per month to exploring the themes of the Gathering
- -monitor Covid numbers to determine safety (this would determine whether we participate in early, regular, or late registration, if it's safe to go)
- -Hold a parent's meeting specially dedicated to the Gathering on **September 26 at 1 p.m. by Zoom** to discuss Covid safety, possible travel plans, and finances
- -Sight-see in Minneapolis for a few days before the event
